# ABBAYE DE DAOULAS



## AN URBAN ABBEY

**The Abbaye de Daoulas groups together numerous points of interest. It is renowned for its medicinal plant and tree garden, featuring species from all over the world, providing visitors with a veritable feast for the senses. Cultural diversity is also honoured through its ambitious exhibition programme, which allows the public to discover other cultures and civilizations.**

Founded in the 12th century by the Canons Regular of the Order of Saint-Augustin, the Abbaye de Daoulas still retains much of its initial splendour: a Romanesque cloister and its remarkable basin, a fountain, and an oratory dating from the 16th century. The medicinal plant gardens, some of which received the "Remarkable Garden" label in 2012, are a must for visitors. These gardens are landscaped in such a way as to showcase the vestiges of the old abbey, and are home to a selection of species from all over the planet, bearing witness to the diversity of pharmacopoeia formed by human societies in treating the body and various diseases.

# CHÂTEAU DE KERJEAN



## SYMBOL OF THE RENAISSANCE

**At the height of Brittany's golden age, towards the end of the 16th century, the Barbier family built a castle that surpassed the most beautiful residences in the region.**

A Renaissance architectural jewel, surrounded by an exceptional walled enclosure to protect it, the Château de Kerjean and its 20-hectare wooded grounds offer a multitude of treasures, both architectural and natural, to be discovered or rediscovered during activities, visits and walks.

Twenty-five rooms can be visited, some equipped with fascinating multimedia displays. The chapel and the regional furniture collection are well worth visiting. The courtyard kitchen, the castle's centrepiece, has just been fully restored. Thanks to new facilities, visitors with reduced mobility can now visit four rooms in the castle that were previously inaccessible to wheelchair-users.

## KERNAULT IS UNDERGOING A FACELIFT...

**In the autumn of 2020, the Finistère Regional Council began restoration work on the Manoir de Kernault. This is taking place in two phases, the first concerns the half-timbered attic, a listed building dating from the 17th century, and the second phase of restoration will centre on the stately home, also listed as a historic monument.**

This restoration campaign will allow this remarkable site to be preserved and to create a new reception area with gift shop and café in the timber-framed attic, along with a new temporary exhibition space and offices. The entire building will be accessible to all visitors.

The grounds remain open to walkers throughout the duration of renovations and a number of events have been programmed over the course of the season.

# ABBAYE DU RELEC



## A CISTERCIAN ABBEY

**Founded in 1132, the Abbaye du Relec comprises a large Romanesque church, convent buildings, ponds, an avenue lined with tall trees, a monumental fountain and meadows surrounded by a moat.**

The abbey church, listed as a historic monument, is a truly remarkable building, a rare witness to Cistercian architecture in Brittany. When it was occupied by the monks, it was also a prosperous agricultural estate, equipped with a hydraulics network that is still visible today. In addition to the abbey and its ruins, visitors can stroll through the grounds, a preserved natural space, which hosts a temporary exhibition in the vegetable garden. Children can choose from a range of activities enabling them to discover the historical and natural features of this extraordinary site in a fun, educational manner. The comfortable new reception area offers visitors the opportunity to learn about the history of the abbey, thanks to an immersive visual and sound system.

## BELLE ÉPOQUE HERITAGE

**In the heart of an 85-hectare park, the Château de Trévarez, recognized as a "20th-century Heritage Site", has overlooked the Aulne Valley for over a century. It bears witness to the ambition of its founder, James de Kerjégu, who in 1893, embarked upon the construction of a prestigious residence, boasting highly modern facilities, against the backdrop of the belle époque.**

This lavish period is honoured in the permanent exhibition *Building a Dream* that takes visitors on a tour of the former owner's private apartments restored in the art-nouveau style, as well as being the subject of the photographic exhibition by Marie Dubuisson, presented outdoors. The grounds, designed as a green setting for the castle, is now home to several major botanical collections. Recognized for the excellence of its collections of camellias and rhododendrons, Trévarez has been awarded the "Remarkable Garden" distinction and has been one of the world's largest camellia gardens since 2016.

## ON THE BANKS OF THE AULNE DURING THE BELLE ÉPOQUE

The exhibition, open since the spring of 2020, has been added to with a dozen photographs, thereby revealing more of the collection of almost two hundred photographic plates found in the attic of Marie Dubuisson's family home in Châteauneuf-du-Faou. Born in 1879, this amateur photographer immortalized her daily life: boat trips, paddling at the seaside, etc. The exhibition provides a moving panorama of the life of a bourgeois family in central Finistère in the 1900s. Over thirty black and white photographs are exhibited in the former vegetable garden and near the large *Labotanique* greenhouse.

## FREEWHEELING

A movement, from the inside to the outside, from one inner world to another...

## IN UNKNOWN LANDS?

The world in the 15th century

This is the first part of a cycle focusing on global expansion during the Renaissance, particularly the period just before the "Great Discoveries".

The exhibition allows visitors to observe the four main parts of the world in the 15th century and its various protagonists: from the Ming of the Chinese Empire to the Incas of the Andes, as well as the powers on the chessboard that was Europe. Despite the isolation and distance between these continents, the movement of people and goods shaped an interconnected world. Maps, old objects and books, animated films and contemporary works arouse our curiosity and testify to the specificity of this universe between known and unknown lands.
