ABBAYE DE DAULAS

Founded in the 12th century, the Abbaye de Daoulas boasts the rare privilege of combining numerous points of interest for visitors – the charming garden, rich with botanical diversity, the patrimonial aspects of the site and a programme of exhibitions exploring the theme of cultural diversity.

CHÂTEAU DE KERJEAN

The Château de Kerjean was built at the end of the 16th century. Typical of the Henri II style in terms of its design and decor, the château is surrounded by an impressive outer wall. Today, the château sits at the centre of a 20-hectare estate that features a dovecote, pillars of justice and a fountain.

From 7 - 22 February, from 1 October to 1 November and from 21 December to 3 January 2016: every day [except Tuesday, closed on 25 December and 1 January 2016] from 2pm to 5.30pm
From 28 March to 30 June and from 1 - 30 September: every day [except Tuesday and excluding special events] from 2pm to 6pm
From 1 July to 31 August: every day from 10am to 6.30pm

MANOIR DE KERNAULT

Constructed in the 15th century, with its half-timbered granary dating from the 17th century, the Manoir de Kernault is located at the centre of a 30-hectare estate that features woods, meadows, a fishpond and orchards producing apple cider.

ABBAYE DU RELEC

The Abbaye du Relec was founded in the 12th century at the heart of the Monts d'Arrée mountain range. The Roman church and the relics of the cloisters bear witness to the presence and influence of the Cistercian monks for over 6 centuries.

From 1 January to 7 May and from 2 November to 31 December: reception and vegetable garden closed

From 8 May to 30 June and 1 September to 1 November: Thursday to Sunday from 10am to 12.30pm and 2pm to 6pm

From 1 July to 31 August: Tuesday to Sunday from 10am to 12.30pm and 2pm to 6pm

Free entry to the grounds all year, except during shows and concerts

Abbey-church closed for renovation work until June 2015

Overlooking the Aulne Valley, the Domaine de Trévarez bears the distinction of '20th Century Heritage Site' for its château and the garden was awarded the 'Remarkable Gardens of France' label for its park and botanical collections.

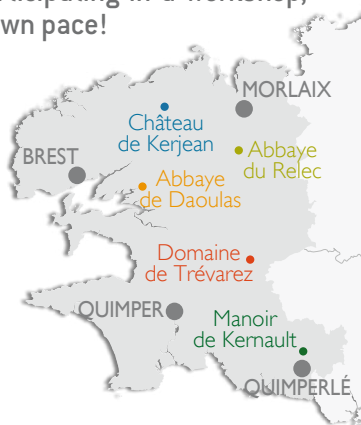

» BEAUTIES IN A BELLE ÉPOQUE GARDEN

Photographic exhibition by Constant Puyo
in the grounds of the demesne

From 7 March

Once again this year, photography from the Belle Époque is exhibited in the gardens of Trévarez with the work of Constant Puyo. His photographs are an ode to beauty: they depict graceful women adorned with long robes against the backdrop of a peaceful and idyllic countryside. The artistic photographs are displayed throughout the grounds, at a bend in a pathway or in a flower-filled meadow, lulling the visitor into a romantic reverie.

Constant Puyo was born in Morlaix in 1857 and was a fervent advocate of photography as an art form. He was one of the leading figures of the French Pictorialist movement.

» A SPECIAL DAY

Photographic Exhibition by Gérard Uféras
in the Abbey gardens
From 27 March

Some thirty photographs by Gérard Uféras depict weddings: from the first meeting to the wedding day, from the preparations to the celebrations, including both civil and religious ceremonies. These moments, captured by the photographer's lens, subtly translate the joy and jubilation, as well as the solemnity or gravity of the occasion. The photographs are accompanied by a short text written by the newlyweds, detailing their meeting, their expectations, and their view of marriage, thus revealing a portrait of humanity in its diversity, but with a shared aspiration: to construct something together, beyond differences.

The exhibition continues in Daoulas. Displayed in the streets of the town or framed in doorways, these images transform residents' view of their town.

CHÂTEAU DE KERJEAN

» HUNTERS ON THE HUNT

Stately hunts in the 16th century
From 28 March to 1 November

Hunting in the 16th century represented the ultimate pleasure of the country gentleman: the Château de Kerjean and its estate are the ideal surroundings in which to evoke such a theme. This exhibition explains, thanks to the old objects and animated films on display, the subtleties and diversities of hunting techniques of that era. Contemporary works, displayed alongside the universe of hunting, provide a poetic, and at times, humorous, if somewhat offbeat perspective. This mixing of genres allows the exhibition to offer a mischievous portrayal of a practice that still gives rise to numerous debates today.

This new exhibition-experience looks at a practice that is especially important to the Finistère region: the ball. A meeting place for various generations and different social classes, the ball was a very special moment of 'letting loose', of which there are many stories to be told.

Punctuated by the accounts of hall owners, musicians, dancers and even rowdy characters, this exhibition-experience begins in front of the manor house, just as the musicians arrive, and leads visitors to the dance floor, with stops at the bar and the orchestra stage.

Have a ball!

This unique exhibition-experience allows families to discover the various facets of the ball and to end their visit waltzing to the sound of the accordion or doing the twist to the strains of rock 'n' roll!

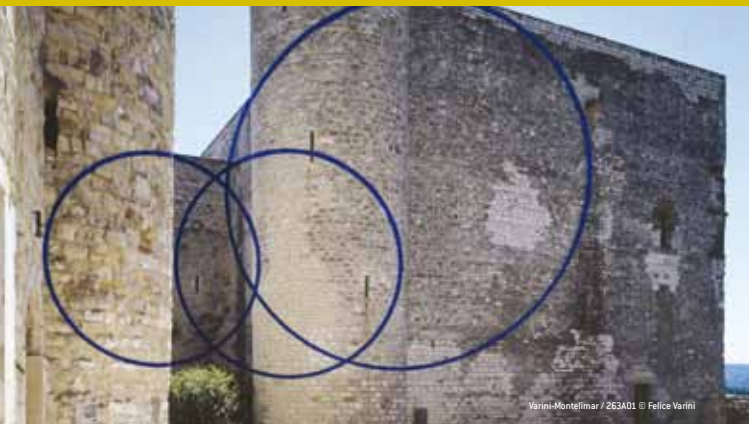

Marriage with or without love? For life or for a certain period of time? Marriage between two or more? A lavish ceremony or an intimate affair? There are so many different types of unions that go by the name of 'marriage'. So, what is marriage? Can one define a universal model? This exhibition delves into the secrets of marriages all over the world in order to examine the different ways of being 'together' in 2015. Works of art, ethnographic objects, testimonies, songs and cinema are all combined here, shifting the boundaries and unsettling common beliefs so as to better create a portrait of the multiple faces of marriage.

DOMAINE DE TRÉVAREZ

» ZIGZAGS ON THE CASTLE and ELLIPSE OF RED BENCHES

Art Installations by Felice Varini

From 9 May to 11 October

Felice Varini, the guest artist at the Domaine de Trévarex in 2015, is known all over the world for his work on perception and, more precisely, on the question of perspective. Depending on the places for which the work is created, he determines the exact spot from which fragments of lines drawn on an architectural ensemble converge to form a figure. Inspired by the neo-Gothic architecture of the château de Trévarex, he explores the volumes, lights and space of this impressive structure. In creating a piece of artwork that gradually comes to life as we move around it, the artist provides us with a fresh vision of the castle and the surrounding gardens.

REGARD D'ARTISTE

His two complementary installations focus on, and around, the castle. One, entitled *Zigzags sur le château*, visible on two of the four castle walls, is made up of silver outlines directly affixed to the brick; the other *Ellipse de bancs rouges* is located opposite the formal garden, in front of the castle, and consists of an installation of about twenty benches in accordance with a predefined geometric logic. Through the two installations found on the demesne, Felice Varini challenges the vision that regular visitors to this prestigious heritage site may have, accentuating the charm and beauty of the castle and grounds for the duration of the summer season.

CHÂTEAU DE KERJEAN

» THE RICH HOURS OF KERJEAN

Circa 1570, the lords of Kerjean embarked on a large-scale construction project. They built, on the site of the former manor, a Renaissance-style castle which was larger and more beautiful than all the other stately houses of the region. This refined edifice, protected behind its impressive ramparts, has been subjected to all manner of indignities over the course of its long history. The *Les Riches Heures de Kerjean*, which translates as *The Rich Hours of Kerjean* allows visitors to explore the past and the architecture of the château thanks to a range of innovative multimedia devices: films, an animated scale model and even a glass explorer plunge visitors back to Renaissance times for a more than memorable experience!

» BUILDING A DREAM

Exhibition at the château
From 7 March

The history of the Domaine de Trévarez has been profoundly influenced by one man, James de Kerjégu. This rich politician, torn between his desire to play an important role at a local level and his aristocratic life amongst the elite of the French capital, decided, over a century ago, to construct a castle equipped with some of the latest technological devices that the period had to offer. The result was not only luxury and modernity. The exhibition highlights the layout of the spaces as they had been originally designed and situates the construction of an undertaking such as Trévarez within the context of the Belle Époque.

NEW IN 2015 » The exhibition at the château is undergoing a facelift! Since 2010, huge efforts have been made to improve the presentation of the site: more and more spaces are now accessible. In line with these changes, exhibition content will be extended in spring 2015.

Since last year, a new area of this site is home to a vegetable garden. Here, visitors may discover, through a visit to its various sections, the evolution of gardens, from the Middle Ages to the present day, as well as learning about the fifty or so sometimes rare species that grow here, such as Catjang or the Common Ice Plant. In addition to the exhibition, visitors can enjoy strolling along the edges of the pond, and the enclosed natural spaces, offering the ideal spot for a moment's rest and contemplation. The garden is also a garden of scents and flavours: a guided visit allows the public to taste some of the plants!

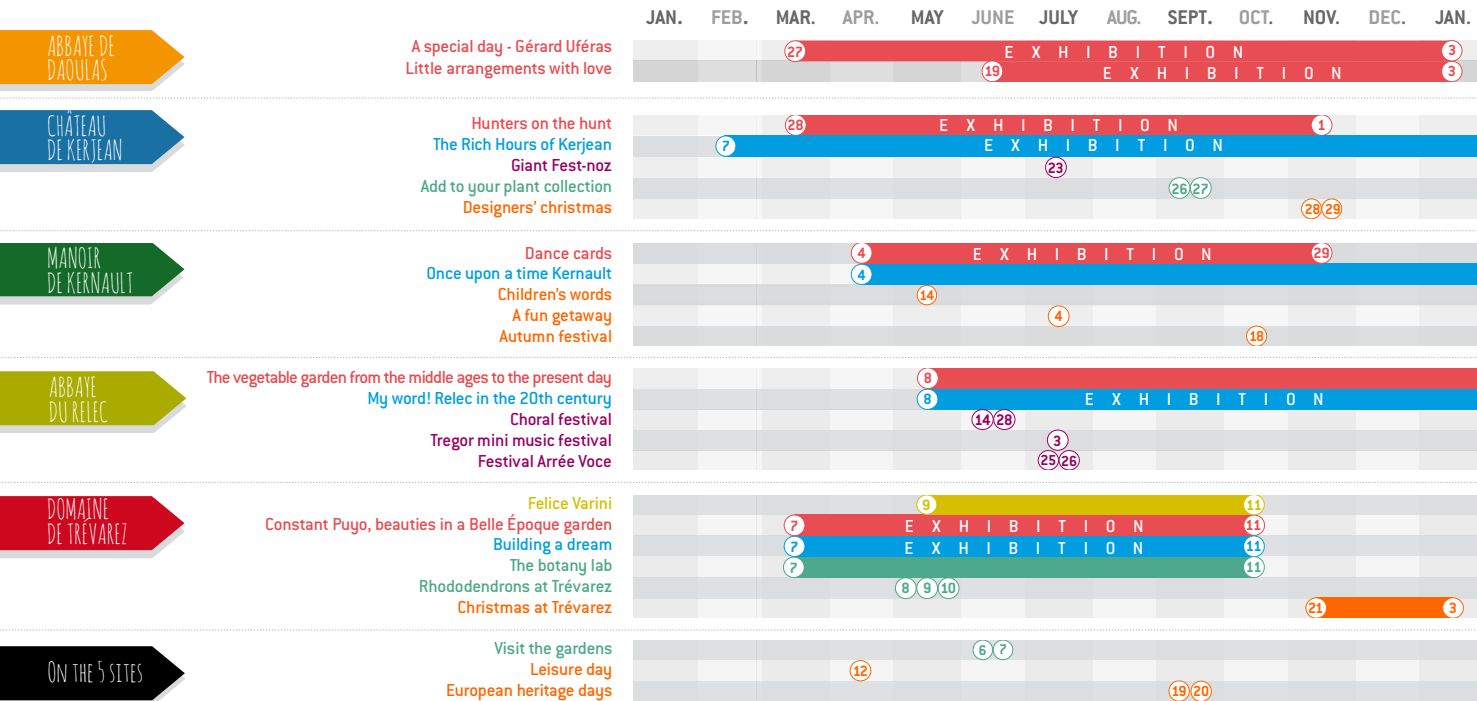

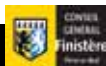
